Our travel agent has informed us that they do not advise for us to travel to Chicago this summer. Additionally, we have to take into consideration the reason that the venues and vendors have not felt that is was safe to re-open. Your safety comes before anything else so we are taking the advice of our travel agent and the warning signs from Chicago. - -Current 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will be refunded 75% of what they have paid towards their trips

We hope the that memories of Cincinnati, Disney, Hershey, and all of our time spent together will last a lifetime. We wish you the best in your future endeavors.
